Duties and Responsibilities

In the Strategic Planning Project Manager position, you will provide analytical and management support including, but not limited to organizational health assessment, strategic planning and measurement, defining roles and responsibilities, process documentation and improvement, team building, leadership training and personnel development. Examples of typical tasks include:

- Conduct situation appraisals and surveys.
- Deliver consultation and facilitation to design and implement a strategic management process and initiatives that lead to individual, group, and organizational performance improvement across the organization.
 - Align performance initiatives with the strategies of the parent organization.
 - Design and facilitate leadership strategy meetings, provide reports summarizing meeting outputs.
 - Support development of performance initiatives, with defined strategic goals and detailed execution action plans.
 - Facilitate and support assigned goal execution action teams
- Meet regularly with leadership to identify, prioritize, and sequence specific tasks.
- Provide as-needed coaching, consulting, facilitation, and products in the areas of conflict resolution, human capital development, strategic communications, standard business practices, performance measurement, value stream analyses, and continuous process improvement.
- Coordinate communications (emails, phone calls, MS Teams video and face-to-face meetings) among stakeholders to facilitate efficient learning events and meetings.
